"It hit me one day – like the light switch had finally turned on. Our Small Group had just come back from a retreat together, and now we were meeting again on our regular weeknight. I've been going to this group for about two years. We've waded through curriculums and studied books of the Bible. We've debated over points and had some deep revelations, but what I realized all of a sudden on this evening as I looked around the room at all my friends, was that God had invaded my heart, had changed my life, and had blessed me immensely *through these people*. Oh, sure, the material is beneficial and good for growth, but God performs His real wonders through individuals. I could honestly say as I gazed around the room: "so this is what Christ-like love looks like. This is what relationships were meant to be." No, we're not perfect, but for someone like me, someone whose life has been characterized by insecurity, fear of rejection, and inadequacy, it was a bit of a shock to realize just what God had done to me through these people. As I sat there I could almost hear God's voice whispering, "See, you *do* have value. People *can* love you. They *do* care." Now I've known these things for some time. I've read them in God's Word, but on that evening, I realized that He had proven it to me. I no longer needed

willpower to believe it. The evidence was there – it was irrefutable, and I could not deny it. I simply smiled at that moment as a sense of calm assurance and joy settled over me – now I get it. Now I see what Small Groups are for."

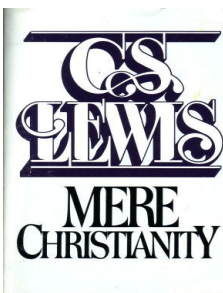

Satan doesn't want this to happen. He would prefer it if you would just keep those blinders on.

# MISSIONS WORLD AWARE FOCUS - ISRAEL

The Symbol of the First Christians in Jerusalem. This symbol shows how the beliefs of the first Christians were distinctly Jewish. It features the seven branched Temple menorah, the base of which merges with the tail of the fish, producing a Star of David. At first glance one sees three symbols, yet in fact, there are only two, the temple Menorah and the ichthys fish. It is only their superimposition that produces the "Star of the Messiah." The Star of David (Magen David or David's Shield) consists of two triangles, the early

Messianic Jews and Christians saw it as representing reconciliation between god and man' one triangle points down from heaven to man and the other triangle from man to god. This star was seen as the fulfillment of the Messianic prophecy of Balaam: "A star shall come forth from Jacob, a scepter shall rise from Israel". (Numbers 24:17). These Jewish symbols are combined with the Gentile Christian ichthys fish, for "there is no distinction between Jew and Greek in the Lord. (Romans 10:12).
